**ORDINANCE NO. 568**

**AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE CITY IN THE  
KANSAS MUNICIPAL ENERGY AGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 12-885 *et seq.* (the "Act") provides that two or more cities may create a municipal energy agency for the purpose of planning, studying and developing supply, transmission and distribution facilities and programs, and for the purpose of securing an adequate, economical and reliable supply of electricity and other energy, and transmitting the same for distribution through the distribution systems of such cities; and

**WHEREAS**, certain cities have heretofore by agreement (the "Agreement") created the Kansas Municipal Energy Agency (the "Agency"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Arma, Kansas (the "City") is qualified for membership in the Agency as a city organized and existing under the laws of Kansas and authorized by such laws to engage in the local distribution and sale of electrical energy; and


**WHEREAS**, it is hereby deemed advisable that the City become a member of the Agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY  
OF ARMA, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City is hereby authorized to become a member of the Agency.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official newspaper of the City.

**PASSED** by the governing body of the City of Arma, on March 17, 2008, and **SIGNED** by the Mayor.
