

ORDINANCE NO. 568-A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ARMA, KANSAS, DESIGNATING THE GENERAL PURPOSES OF THE REVENUE RECEIVED BY THE CITY UPON THE ELECTORATE APPROVING AN ADDITION TO THE CURRENT CITY RETAILERS SALES TAX IN THE CITY OF ARMA, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (.5%) FROM AND AFTER APRIL 1, 2009, AND ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS AND PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS OF K.S.A. 12-187.

WHEREAS, the governing body has determined that additional revenues are needed to maintain, improve, and repair streets, alleys, curbs and guttering, and street aprons, for streets and alleys located within the city limits of the City of Arma, and that ad valorem property tax increases should be avoided if possible, with the voters given a choice as to whether said improvements should be financed by an additional sales tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ARMA, KANSAS:


Section 1: The City of Arma, Kansas, pursuant to the authority of K.S.A. 12-187, upon the electorate approving an addition to the current city retailers sales tax in the City of Arma in the amount of one-half of one percent (.5%) from and after April 1, 2009, for the purpose of maintaining, improving, and repairing streets, alleys, curbs and guttering and street aprons, for streets and alleys located within the City of Arma and to finance the cost of said improvements and maintenance, which improvements promote the public health, well being and welfare and constitute valid public purposes for the City of Arma.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city paper.

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
Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect sixty-one days after the final publication, unless a sufficient petition for referendum is filed and a referendum held on the Ordinance as provided in K.S.A. 12-137, in which event, the Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, with not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 18 day of August, 2008.
