

ORDINANCE NO. 573

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL CITY RETAILERS SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (0.5%) WITHIN THE CITY OF ARMA, EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2009.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ARMA, KANSAS.

Section 1. A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved at a special question election held on the 4th day of November, 2008, the levying of an additional retailers sales tax in the City of Arma, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187, et seq., as amended, there is hereby levied a city retailers sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (0.5%) to take effect on the first day of April, 2009.

Section 2. The proceeds of said sales tax shall be used to maintain, improve and repair streets, alleys, curbs and guttering and street aprons for streets and alleys within the city limits of the city of Arma.

Section 3. Except as may be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state's retailers sales tax shall apply to such city retailers sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the State Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect said tax.


Section 4. This ordinance shall be published once in the official city newspaper, and a copy duly certified shall be submitted to the State Director of Taxation by the City Clerk.
