

ORDINANCE NO. 609

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ARMA, KANSAS, INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES 44th EDITION" AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 604 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES THAT ARE IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ARMA, CRAWFORD COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Arma, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", 44th Edition of 2016, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, excepting the following: Section 23 Accident involving death or personal injuries; penalties. Section 30. Driving Under Influence. Section 30.1 Driving Commercial Motor Vehicle Under the Influence. Section 30.2 Preliminary Breath Test. Section 30.2.1 Refusal to Submit to Alcohol or Drug Test. Section 88 Parking for certain purposes prohibited. Section 107 Unattended motor vehicles; ignition; key and brakes. Section 194. Driving While License Cancelled, Suspended or Revoked. Section 195.1 Operation of a Motor Vehicle When a Habitual Violator.

Not less than three (3) copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance will be marked or stamped "Official Copy" as adopted by this Ordinance and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge, City Attorney and all the administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed necessary and expedient.

SECTION 2. TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.

(A) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.

(B) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions as defined in subsection (A) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

SECTION 3. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for a violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the Municipal Judge established fines in the fines schedules shall not be less than \$10.00, nor more than \$2,500.00. A person convicted for a violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the Court not to exceed \$2,500.00.


In addition to the fine, the person convicted shall be assessed any cost for jail time served which shall be assessed at the same rate charged to the city by the jail where incarcerated. Said charge shall be in addition to the fine and court costs.

Court costs shall be \$78.00, in conformity with statutory assessments imposed by the Kansas Legislature.


SECTION 4. REPEAL. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper. December, 2016.
