

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-0006

A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND REPEALING CITY ORDINANCE 3-103.

It has been brought to the attention of the City Council of the City of Arma, that City Ordinance 3-103 is stricter with respect to the allowance of minors into facilities that sell alcohol than Kansas State Law.

It has further been discussed by the City Council of the City of Arma, KS, that while the protection of minors is utmost in the mind in the City Council, there are concerns regarding following strict enforcement of laws.

It is further discussed by the City Council of the City of Arma, KS, that amending of City Ordinance 3-103 would be appropriate.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Arma, KS, that City Ordinance 3-103 will be amended and repealed with respect to allowing minors in bars. Minors will be allowed in the bars in the City of Arma, without parental or guardian present from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. In order for a minor to be in the bar after 8:00 p.m., the minor must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

It is therefore resolved by the City Council of the City of Arma, KS, City Ordinance 3-103 shall be amended and repealed as set forth hereinabove. Adopted this 21st day of November, 2016.
