

## **SPECIAL MEETING NOVEMBER 4, 2021**

A Special Meeting was held to discuss the KDOT Business 69 Hwy grant with Tim Aziere engineer with PEC. Roll call was taken and Rock Anderson, Rob Lessen, Dickie Cleland and Mary Lou Peace were present. Also attending the meeting was Tom Gorman and Howard Camp. The meeting began at 10:45 a.m.

Mayor Anderson opened the meeting with any questions to Mr. Aziere. Mary Lou Peace questioned the expense of the project and if the city would be required to pay any overages. Tim stated that KDOT not PEC recently did a 2<sup>nd</sup> design on the project but as far as the City of Arma stands, the cost of the project has not changed at all, plus the project has yet to be bid out. Tim stated that he felt KDOT had overestimated the cost of the project and that it should still be under \$1 million dollars. Tim did inform the City Council that KDOT's policy on building sidewalks has changed and that no sidewalks will be built unless damage has incurred while working the project. Dickie Cleland asked about the width of the project. Tim stated that the lanes will be 12' each in width. Mary Lou Peace brought up the issue of Gary and Carol Harryman's rental on E. Main and N. West St. and that the renter uses the side of the road for parking and the City needs to keep that width. Tim stated that any utility right of way or parking needs would be up to the City Council. Dickie Cleland stated that he wanted to keep the width as it is currently until just north of E. Perry. Tim brought up the rolling curb so that folks could pull up and park parallel to West St. Council liked this idea.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
